Undergraduate topics in Construction Engineering and Management, experimental classes offered at the undergraduate level on a temporary basis to test the viability of offering the course on a permanent basis.

Reason

The intent of the course is to provide a mechanism for experimental courses to be taught at the undergraduate level. Courses will be vetted and monitored by the CEM curriculum committee.
